



CONTACT LENS POLICY

CONTACT LENSES ARE CLASSIFIED AS A MEDICAL DEVICE BY THE FDA & HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO HARM YOUR EYES AND/OR RESULT IN COMPLETE VISION LOSS.

CONTACT LENS EVALUATION: A contact lens evaluation is necessary every year to ensure that your eyes are healthy to wear contact lenses. Your contact lens evaluation fees will cover all trial lenses and follow-ups for a 3-month period for contact lens related issues. There will be an additional fee for each contact lens follow-up visit after the 3-month period.

If a contact lens follow-up is necessary, please come in wearing your contact lenses for at least 4 hours. A contact lens prescription will be finalized at the end of the evaluation only after all follow-ups, if necessary, are completed. The release of your contact lens prescription, good for one year, is conditional on you following the recommended contact lens care and wearing schedule guidelines.

NORMAL SYMPTOMS: It is normal to experience some lens awareness, mild itching or irritation or dryness. Overall, your eyes should be clear, comfortable, and see well while wearing your contact lenses. If you experience pain, severe redness, blurry vision, or anything that does not feel normal to you, please discontinue your lens wear immediately and call our office or come in.

GLASSES: A pair of updated glasses is recommended in case of emergency or if you are unable to wear your contact lenses for any reason, such as an eye infection, and so that you can avoid over-wearing your contact lenses.

Do not swim in your contacts. Never wear your contacts if you do not feel well.

Sleeping in your contact lenses is never recommended. If you do sleep in your contact lenses please understand the potential increased risks for serious eye infections and potential loss of vision.
